Jonathan Stubbs is the principal of Stubbs' Traffic Accident Reconstruction Services Limited (STAR Services), a company formed in 2009. He specialises in road traffic accident reconstruction.

Jonathan has a wide experience, spanning more than 30 years, of all types of road collisions and other traffic incidents.

During 2008 and the early part of 2009, he was a director of and consultant to Traffic Collision Reconstruction & Investigation Limited (TCRI), a firm specializing in traffic accident reconstruction.

Between 2003 and 2008, Jonathan was employed by the Transport Research Laboratory (TRL) based in Berkshire. For nearly two years he staffed the Accident Investigation team for the "On-The-Spot" Accident Data Collection project. This project is funded by the Department for Transport and provides real-world data to assist with understanding the causes and consequences of road traffic collisions and thus, promote the development of better countermeasures. In 2005 Jonathan began to undertake some work for the Investigations and Incident Reconstruction Group at TRL and then transferred to work full-time, as a senior consultant, for that group in 2006 where he conducted many reconstructions

Prior to joining TRL, he served as a police officer for 27 years. Of this time, he was a traffic patrol officer for 19 years, specializing as a collision investigator for 15 years.

His training and qualifications encompass the following subjects:

- Advanced car and motor cycle driving, together heavy goods vehicle driving;
- motor vehicle inspection;
- tachograph chart analysis;
- national and international road haulage operations competence;
- accident investigation, vehicle dynamics and traffic accident reconstruction (in these subjects, he has qualifications from both the UK and the USA); and
- computer based animation of accident reconstruction.
